Details: People with even addresses are asked to bring a bottle of wine, and those with odd addresses a dessert

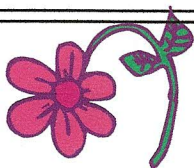




THE RELIGHTING OF AUDUBON LAKE ENTRANCE

We are in the process of updating the front entrance lighting. This is phase one and will be completed by the end of November. We are replacing the existing lights that now light the oaks with compact florescent fixtures, ground fault protection and energy efficient lamps. We will be replacing the existing incandescent flood lights that light the Audubon Lake sign with the same energy efficient fluorescent lamps. Other improvements are going to be done next year and will include both sides with up-lighting of the trees and landscape with lamps designed for this purpose. This is going to give the subdivision more appeal during the nighttime hours, be energy efficient, and of course, help with safety issues.
